- picturesque (town): ADJECTIVE UK / pik.tfər'esk/ US / pik.tfər'esk/ (especially of a place) attractive in appearance, especially in an old-fashioned way
- enduring (tradition): ADJECTIVE UK /ın'dʒʊə.rıŋ/ US /ın'dʊr.ɪŋ/ existing for a long time
- (to serve as the) epitome (of sth): NOUN UK /ıˈpɪt.ə.mi/ US /ıˈpɪţ.ə.mi/ the typical or best example of something
- lavish (constructions): ADJECTIVE UK /ˈlæv.ɪʃ/ US /ˈlæv.ɪʃ/ expensive or impressive
- sophisticated (design): ADJECTIVE UK /səˈfis.tı.kei.tıd/ US /səˈfis.tə.kei.ţıd/ complicated or made with great skill
- cutting-edge (amenities): ADJECTIVE UK /ˌkʌt.ɪŋ'edʒ/ US /ˌkʌt̞.ɪŋ'edʒ/ very modern and with all the newest features
- staggering (price tags): ADJECTIVE UK /'stæg.ər.ıŋ/ US /'stæg.ə.ɪŋ/ very shocking and surprising

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
